

SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTO INFORMATION

Senior pictures must be delivered to Mr. Daniels, the yearbook advisor, by **December 10, 2021**. Any photo submitted after this date is NOT guaranteed to appear in the yearbook. Please read the following specifications carefully. For consistency of production on the color senior pages, the yearbook portraits must meet these specifications:

YEARBOOK SENIOR PORTRAIT SPECIFICATIONS

1. Choose a standard, formal **head-and-shoulders** photo. Photos that are submitted with a full-body pose will be cropped down to head-and-shoulders.
2. **Electronic copies are preferred. They turn out better than print copies.** We no longer have a size requirement. We will scan your picture, and we can size it to meet our needs. Wallet size photos are acceptable as long as there is no print on the front. **We cannot use a print that has a copyright notice on it.** Make sure your photographer knows you need a yearbook print. They will print a special copy or make a special electronic copy for yearbook use.
3. Do **NOT** send a screenshot. They are not of a high enough resolution to be printed.
4. If possible, please choose a plain background taken indoors. Our senior portrait section is a formal section of the yearbook, so we would prefer these photos. However, we will accept outdoor photos if you do not have any others. We do not accept photos with props, trucks, shotguns, horses, dogs, musical instruments, sports equipment, or any other items.
5. Senior portraits submitted to yearbook WILL NOT be returned. Please make a copy before submitting.
6. All portraits must be received by the yearbook advisor by **December 10, 2021**. Please email photos to: yearbook@flushingschools.org. We can also accept CDs/USB drives delivered to the high school.
7. Do not give your picture to other students to deliver.
8. If you are unsure about getting senior pictures, you can get your picture taken on the school picture day for no cost. This picture can then be used in the yearbook. Otherwise, if no picture is submitted, there will be no picture in the yearbook.

Note for parents: For your own convenience, most area portrait studios will prepare special prints or CDs and get them to us before the deadline. Check to see if your photographer plans to do this. We highly recommend scheduling your portrait sittings for the summer or early fall. Seniors will be very busy next year and the time will fly by.
