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## **Advisory Syllabus**

**Advisory period will begin at 8:00 every day.**

**The following is the layout for Advisory, please plan accordingly:**

On **Mondays** we will have Enrichment activities in which the students will be engaging in. They may include discussing current events, CNN news, or activities/games promoting lessons within the Advisory curriculum. We have a new advisory curriculum this year called The Positivity Project.

On **Tuesday and Thursdays** (Study Skills Days) they are required to bring homework, it is not acceptable to say "I have nothing to do" on these days. All eighth graders have a reading assignment that is required by their English teachers, therefore, they can always be reading on Study Skills Days. I am also available to help with math questions on these days.

On **Wednesdays** we will be participating in Character Education activities (Positivity Project).

On **Fridays** we will be watching the Broadcast that is presented by Miss Gibson's Broadcast class. Planner checks, worth 10 points, will also be done on this day.

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### **Policy & Procedures:**

**Bathroom/Drink Passes:** None will be given, the class is only 23 minutes.

**Classroom Discipline:** Students are expected to follow the responsibilities and procedures of the classroom and Flushing Middle School. Disruptions take time away from the classroom activities and will not be tolerated. A verbal warning to the student will be given. If the problem cannot be resolved with the classroom, a phone call home, or referral to the office will be given.

**Class Preparation:** Students are expected to bring a pencil and their planner to class each day. Some form of homework must be brought to class on Tuesday and Thursdays - no exceptions.
