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Syllabus for Pre-Algebra 8

Assignments/Homework: Homework will be assigned most days for 10 points. It is required students put effort into every problem and show their work, no credit will be given for "non-logical" or "unreasonable" answers. 5 points will be given for incomplete or late work, and 1 point will be given indicating a student is absent, in which they will then have 2 days to complete their absent work for full credit. Most days, time will be given in class to complete the assignment, however, he/she may still need additional time at home to finish the lesson. Assignments are due the next day, late assignments can be turned in up to 2 days later for $\frac{1}{2}$ credit. All homework must be turned into their Google Classroom, students must "submit work" with a picture attached for credit. All assignments will be discussed and gone over in class the following day.

Absences/Google Classroom: At the beginning of each week, I will post the "Agenda" for the week, which will include homework assignments. Students who are absent will be expected to view the teaching video that will be posted in the Google Classroom under "Materials." The entire chapter will have homework videos for each lesson posted so students may go back at any time to watch the lesson/s. Work must be submitted within 2 days of their absence for full credit.
